155th BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF ANDRES BONIFACIO

Memorandum Circular No. 2018-193

November 5, 2018



1.0 Background

- 1.1. The nation will commemorate the 155th Birth Anniversary of Andres Bonifacio on November 30, 2018, being a Filipino revolutionary leader and one of the most influential national heroes of our country during the Philippine Revolution against Spanish colonial rule.

2.0 Purpose

This Circular enjoins all local government units and DILG officials and personnel, to commemorate the 155th Birth Anniversary of Andres Bonifacio.

3.0 Scope/Coverage

All Provincial Governors, City Mayors, Municipal Mayors, DILG Regional Directors, ARMM Regional Governor, and all others concerned

4.0 Policy Content and Guidelines

- 4.1. The National Historical Commission of the Philippines and the City Government of Caloocan, in collaboration with other government agencies, and the private sector, will lead the flag-raising and wreath-laying rites at the Andres Bonifacio National Monument, Caloocan City, on November 30, 2018 at 8:00 o'clock in the morning.
- 4.2. All Local Chief Executives and all DILG Regional Offices are enjoined to conduct simple but meaningful activities such as flag-raising and wreath-laying rites, display of Philippine flag in LGU and DILG offices, and other related activities in their respective localities.
- 4.3. All DILG Regional Directors and the ARMM Regional Governor are likewise enjoined to cause the widest and immediate dissemination of this issuance to all local government units within their Regions.
