Subject: TEEN NEGOSYO UNIVERSITY (4TH TEEN NEGOSYO)

The Philippine Center for Entrepreneurship (PCE), in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA), Office of Presidential Consultant on Entrepreneurship Joey A. Concepcion III and the Department of Trade and Industry-Philippine Trade Training Center (DTI-PTTC) will hold the Teen Negosyo University (4th Teen Negosyo), which is under the banner of PCE's GO NEGOSYO campaign on 26-31 July 2009 at the Teacher's Camp, Baguio City.

The theme for this year is "TEEN NEGOSYO UNIVERSITY: WE'RE IN BUSINESS (HOW TO GO NEGOSYO)". The training aims to assist the youth as they begin to responsibly engage in entrepreneurial activities and endeavors; inspire them to consider entrepreneurship as a career; and strengthen entrepreneurship education and learning, among others. Activities during the events include plenary sessions, interactive break-out sessions, competitions and entertainment.

All Provincial Governors, City/Municipal Mayors and Punong Barangays are hereby encourage to allow their respective Sangguniang Kabataan Officials to attend the activity on official time. Payment of registration fee in the amount of Four Thousand Nine Hundred Pesos (PhP4,900.00), to cover accommodation and meals, training kits, certificates, reproduction of modules, speakers' honoraria, light and sound services, prizes, communications, events and consultancy services, T-shirts, bags; travel and other incidental expenses of the event, is hereby authorized, chargeable against their respective local funds, subject to the availability thereof and the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures, and provided further, that the 20% Development Fund shall not be utilized for the purpose.
