# ANTI-MONEY LAUNDERING ACT OF 2001

REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9160

Section 7(1) of the AMLA authorizes the AMLC to require, receive and analyze covered and suspicious transaction reports from covered persons. To be able to file the reports, Rule 22, Section 4, of the 2018 IRR requires covered persons to register with the AMLC's electronic reporting system.





ANY COVERED PERSON WHO, KNOWING
THAT A COVERED OR SUSPICIOUS
TRANSACTION IS REQUIRED TO BE
REPORTED TO THE AMLC, FAILS TO DO SO
SHALL BE **GUILTY** OF ML UNDER THE LAST

## "Safe Harbor Provision" RULE 22, SECTION 6, OF THE 2018 IRR

There is a legal assurance that covered persons shall not be held administratively, criminally, or civilly liable for filing covered and suspicious transaction reports in the regular performance of his duties and in good faith.

"Confidentiality Provision"
RULE 22, SECTION 7, OF THE 2018 IRR

Covered persons are prohibited from communicating, directly or indirectly, in any manner or by any means, to any person or entity, or the media, that a covered or suspicious transaction has been or is about to be reported, its contents or any other information in relation thereto.
